

<p>Deta Connect Home Thermostat can be controlled by the Connect App by pairing it with the Connect Link hub.</p> <p>The Home Thermostat can be set &amp; reset remotely – Home or Away, provided there's a Broadband connection.</p> <p>The Home Thermostat can control virtually any UK heating system – full user details can be found on the Deta Connect web site. Overview	Connecting to the App
 <p>The Home Thermostat is used to control and schedule home heating. It Wirelessly links to Deta Connect Boiler Switch which turns on and off your boiler. If the Thermostat is also linked to the Deta Connect Link, you can also control and schedule your heating via the Deta Connect App.</p> <p>The Home Thermostat can perform many functions, including setting target temperature, operating modes, and creating a schedule, Away &amp; Holiday modes, Frost mode etc – Please refer to the online instructions for full details.</p>	<p><b>Connecting to the App</b> <b>Linking the Thermostat to the Deta Connect App</b></p>  <p>To Use the Deta Connect App to control the Home Thermostat, you will first need to install the Deta Connect Link. This allows any Deta Connect device to be linked to and controlled by a smartphone, tablet or PC. The thermostat can be linked to the App using the following method:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Download the App and follow the in-App setup instructions to setup the Deta Connect Link and App. Access the 'heating' section on the menu and follow the instructions regarding how to add a heating device.</li> <li>2. When prompted, press and release the 'Link' button on the Thermostat (the on and off LEDs will flash alternately).</li> <li>3. Send the linking command from the App (the in-App instructions will explain how to do this). The 'on' LED should flash to indicate a successful link.</li> </ol>

Linking a Home Thermostat with a Boiler Switch	
 <p>If you are using the Electric Switch AND Deta Connect Home Thermostat to control your boiler, you will need to first link the switch to the thermostat, and then link the thermostat (only) to the App. The Electric Switch can be linked to the Thermostat using the following method.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press and release the 'linking' button on the Electric Switch (the on and off LEDs will flash alternately).</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Press and release the 'linking' button on the Home Thermostat. 'Link OK' should appear on the display to indicate a successful link.</li> </ol> <p>To unlink a Home Thermostat, press and release the linking button on the Electric Switch and then press the Standby button. This activates the 'unlinking mode'. Press the linking button on the Thermostat. The 'deleted' should flash on the screen to indicate that the devices have been unlinked.</p> <p>To completely clear the memory of the Electric Switch, press and release the Linking button. Then hold the linking button until the LEDs flash rapidly. Finally, press and release the linking button once more. The Off LED should flash.</p>
